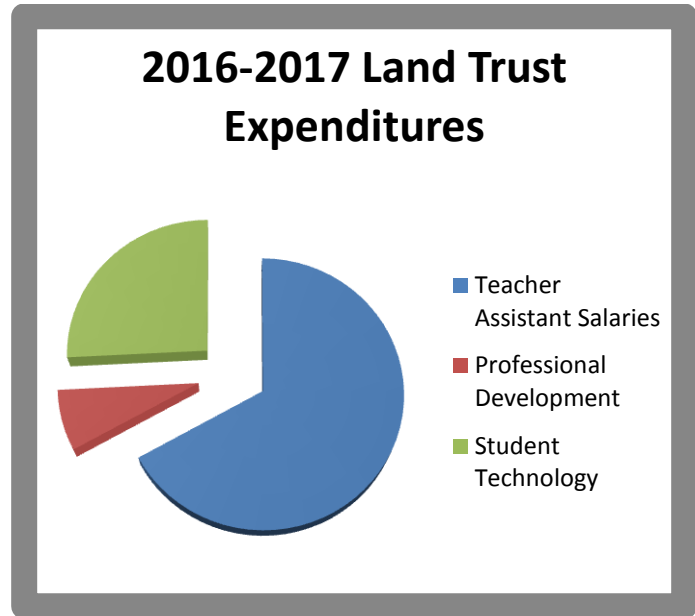

# School Community Council

The Utah Legislature requires all schools to establish a School Community Council (SCC) to provide input, receive feedback, and have a stewardship over a number of important school duties. Specifically, the SCC responsibilities include: creating a school improvement plan, managing School Land Trust monies (approximately \$51,044 dollars for our school), assisting with professional development, analyzing school data and assessing student academic needs.

**Last year the SCC allocated Land Trust monies in the following ways:**

Professional Development	\$3,574
Student Technology	\$12,706



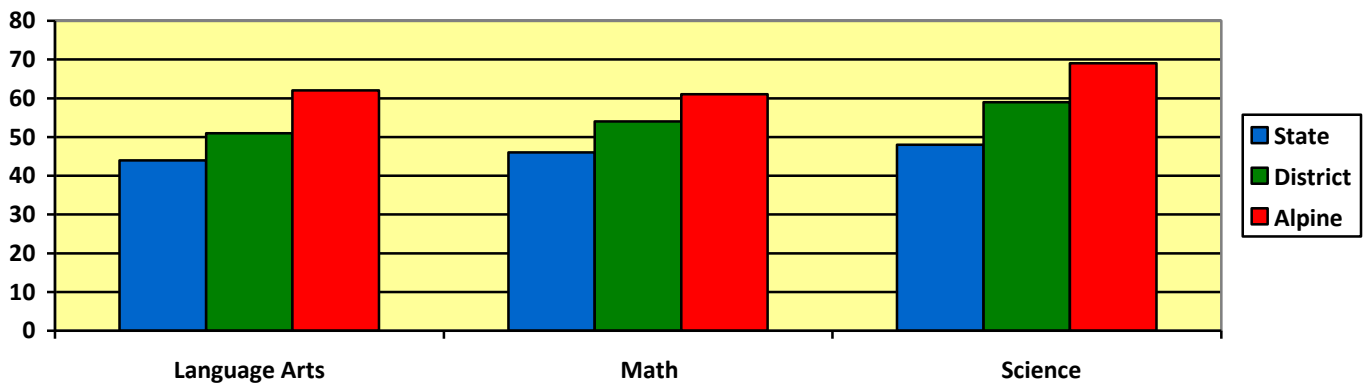
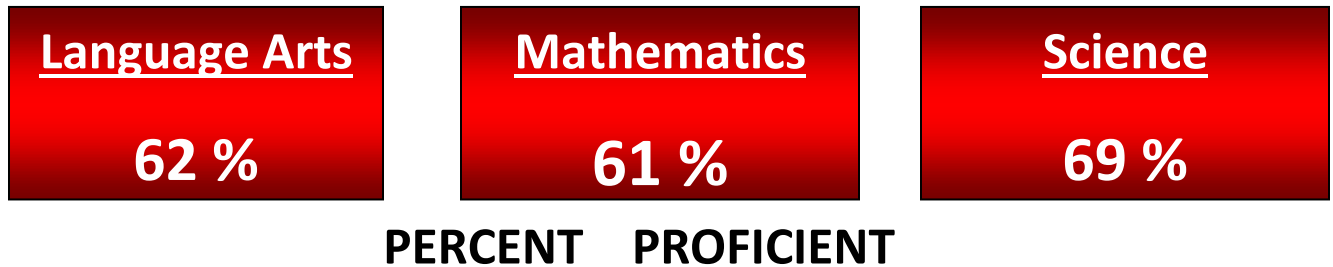
## What Makes Alpine Elementary Unique?
