- On-line registration opens Wednesday, March 30, 2016 at 7:00 A.M.
- Registration is on a **first-come-first-served** basis and many weeks fill up within the first hours of registration. Please be prepared in advance with multiple choices that work for your family.

(Note: There will not be an all boys week nor an all girls week this summer.)

• The registration fee of \$225.00 must be paid in full at the time of registration.

Registration fee pays for school bus transportation to and from camp (departing from Lindon Elementary School Monday morning and returning Friday afternoon), four nights of lodging, all meals and snacks, camp booklet, craft materials, instructional supplies, Clear Creek Camp T-shirt, and personnel expenses.
