Alpine Elementary opened its doors in our current location in January of 1965, and for the past 56 years has provided the children of Alpine a quality education. We believe that all children are entitled to a learning experience that enables them to achieve to their highest potential.

In addition to teaching the State Core Learning Standards, we emphasize strong citizenship skills at Alpine Elementary. Our students are all familiar with the six C's: Collaboration, Communication, Creativity, Critical Thinking, Citizenship and Character. Additionally, Alpine Elementary students practice the Alpine Big 3 daily: "Today I will be respectful, responsible and ready to learn."

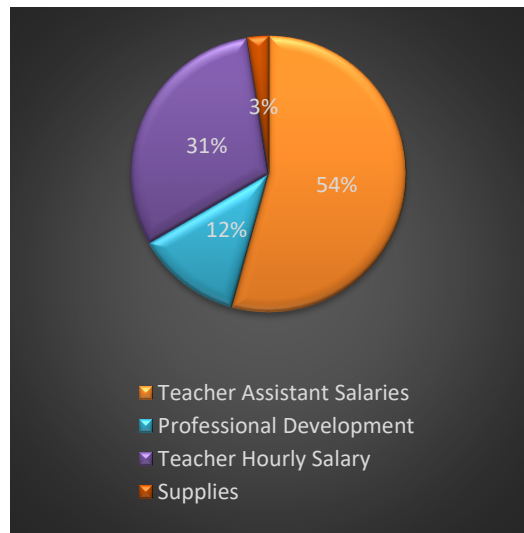

# School Community Council

The Utah Legislature requires all schools to establish a School Community Council (SCC) to provide input, receive feedback, and have a stewardship over a number of important school duties. Specifically, the SCC responsibilities include creating a school improvement plan, assessing student academic needs and managing School Land Trust monies. Alpine Elementary was allocated \$81,000 in the 2019-20 school year. The SCC set two primary student achievement goals in our School Improvement Plan for the 2019-20 school year: 1) 85% Acadience proficiency for K-3 graders, 2) a 50 median growth percentile in RISE tests for 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> graders.

**Land Trust monies were spent in the following ways to accomplish the 2019-20 School Improvement Plan goals as approved by the School Community Council:**

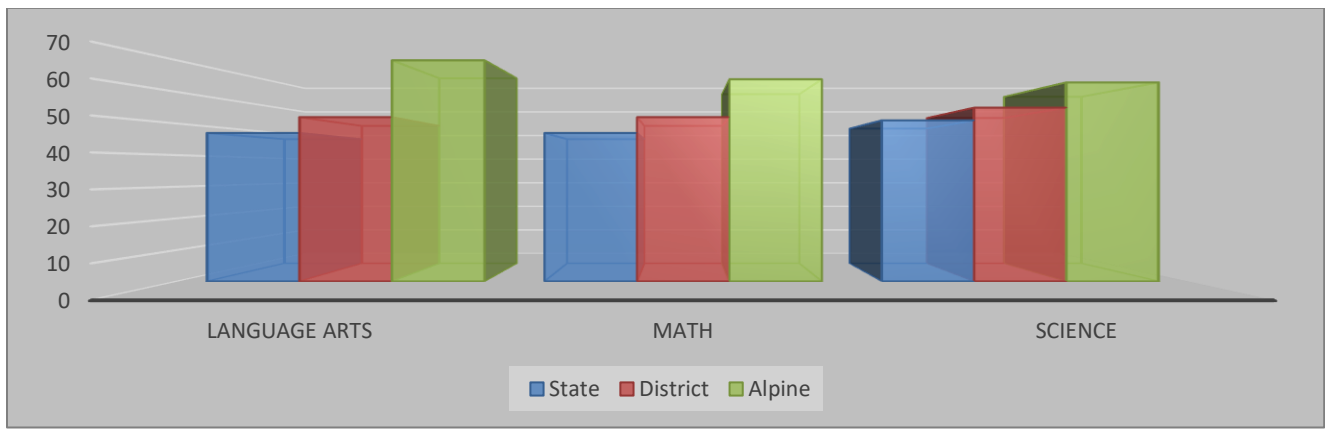
# STATE TESTS (RISE) ASSESSMENT DATA 2018-19

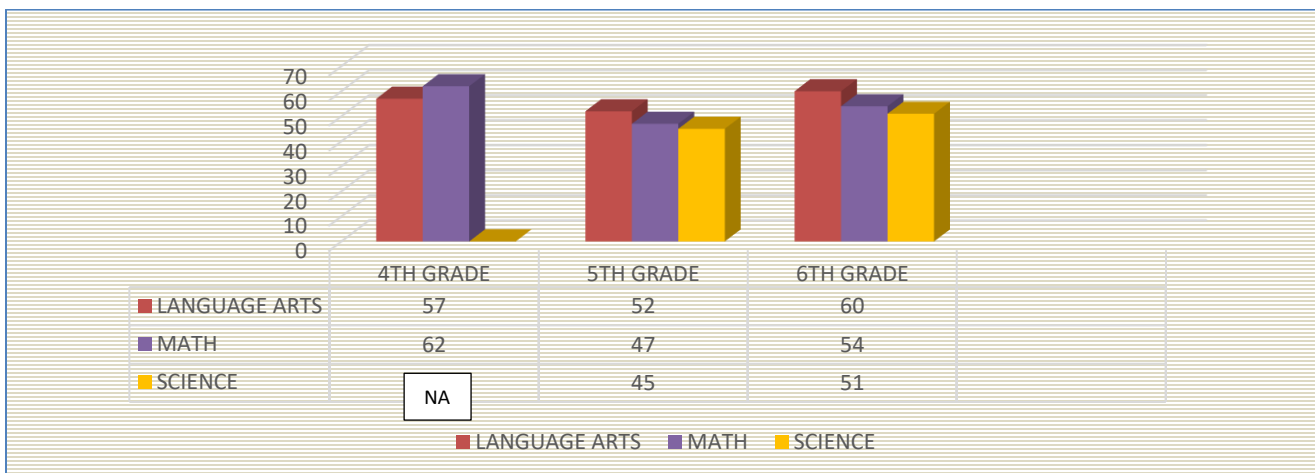


**PERCENT PROFICIENT**
